We will become a member congregation of Minnesota Interfaith Power & Light (MN IPL) by agreeing to do one or more of the following each year:

- Educate our members about climate change from a faith perspective
- Conduct a lighting or energy audit of our buildings to identify sources of energy waste and potential financial savings
- Make energy efficiency improvements to our congregation's buildings
- Encourage members to reduce their use of energy at home and at work through participation in the Minnesota Energy Challenge or other energy reduction programs
- Use renewable energy by purchasing wind power or installing solar panels
- Advocate for public policies that reduce emissions of greenhouse gases in a just manner
- Encourage members of our congregation to sign up with IPL so that they will receive information and action items from IPL
- Provide financial assistance for projects in developing nations that help to mitigate climate change (such as the development of renewable energy technology or reforestation projects)

And we will support MN IPL financially. The guideline for support is one dollar per year per congregant. MN IPL provides networking meetings, electronic newsletters, advocacy alerts, assistance with organizing a green team, and education and worship resources.
